





### Starting out (DV1 XL 2 version only)

The DV1 XL 2 version features a micro SD card slot that requires a micro SD card to operate.

To insert memory please open the AV/Micro SD tab. Notice the slot and insert any micro SD card, up to 128GB max, SDHC recommended. Insert the card and press it in until it clicks into place. The camera will now recognize the card as the device storage and is now ready for use.
